



Incident Report

Date of Incident: December 18, 2024 Time of Incident: 2308

Location of Incident: Purple Cat/ Inner Basin at D-Dock thru A-Dock

Description of person(s) and/or vehicle(s) involved: Samuel Hendrickson, attacker. Unknown victim, first name Justin.

Details of incident: While on foot patrol for our dock walk, Officer Smith and I observed an unknown **subject rolling around on the ground like a cat on catnip** next to the filet station container. **Obviously under the influence**, but not bothering anyone. We decided to wait to move him along until after we got back to the patrol truck. We then observed Samuel Hendrickson walking northbound through the inner basin coming from the BSRV area yelling and cussing to himself something about someone owing him money and "you're not a friend a friend wouldn't do that". No one around him. He proceeded towards the Purple Cat and began verbally attacking the unknown person there. **Once I heard the unknown guy yell "You're gonna pull a knife on me"** I called 911 and reported a knife fight in progress. They went back and forth for a minute or 2 then Samuel began walking back into the inner basin while still yelling and cussing at the guy. Officer Aguirre was first to arrive on scene, I sent her over to Officer Smith who had kept his eyes on Samuel Hendrickson. Officer Aguirre asked me to stay with the victim who identified as "Justin". I have never seen this guy before this incident. Police arrived at the inner basin and apprehended Samuel Hendrickson and Officer Aguirre came back to take our statement. I was clear in telling her that I/we did not actually see a knife but I could see that Samuel Hendrickson had an object in his hand while chasing "Justin". All LEOs left shortly after.



Incident Report

Description of person(s) and/or vehicle(s) involved: Francisco (Known fisherman) and an alleged employee of Wesley Taylor (unknown name, drives old grey Toyota pickup with a utility flat bed, white male appx 50 years of age 200lbs with light brown/blonde hair wearing grey sweat pants and shirt)

Details of incident: While on a basic patrol I was stopped by Francisco on Citizens dock road while I was beginning to turn into BSRV B-Row from Citizens. He rode his 3 wheeled bicycle into the oncoming lane and stopped my turn. I rolled my window down while looking ahead at a small truck coming towards us, I told Francisco that he cant stop in the road here its not safe and told him to watch out pointing at the oncoming truck. I put my arm out of the drivers window in a "STOP" motion but the driver did not stop or slow down. Francisco's bicycle was struck completely destroying the back right wheel and axle. Francisco was thrown to the ground directly below my drivers' door so I was unable to immediately get out without stepping on him or hitting him with the door. He rolled over crying out in pain and I was able to get out of the truck. I turned on the emergency flashers to warn another oncoming vehicle of the accident. This second vehicle narrowly missed hitting Francisco's bike. The driver who hit Francisco's bicycle did stop and park but seemed to not care about the accident. The second driver got out of his vehicle and began blaming Francisco for getting hit, he knew Francisco by name. I offered to call EMS but Francisco refused medical aide or police stating he was ok and was going to push his bicycle to Isaac's house. Francisco was able to self-ambulate after I helped him up off the ground. The driver who struck Francisco just stood there the whole time with a blank look on his face, perhaps he was in shock. Francisco stated that the driver "Needed to fix his bike why were you going so fast now is broken", however I do not believe the driver was going faster than the posted 25MPH speed limit. Francisco did have the right-of-way but was dressed in all black clothing and in the middle of the road in the dark. His bicycle does have reflectors but no forward or rear facing lights, instead he was holding a small flashlight which was on at the time of impact. The driver left the scene, without even apologizing, before I could speak to him. Approximately 1 hour later, Francisco limped his way over to me and stated he was going to the hospital and asked if I would have a report of this incident tomorrow. Nothing further.
